Driving Directions

From I-40, take Exit #163 to Grand Canyon Blvd. Follow GC Blvd. south to the 2nd stop sign. Turn right onto Railroad Ave. Continue for 2 blocks and turn left onto 4th St. which becomes Perkinsville Rd. 1.9 mi., past the reservoir, until you see the left turn lane and a green "Lost Canyon" sign.

Why Metamorphosis?

The strongest rocks are metamorphic rocks. They form when weaker rocks are heated and put under pressure. As they go through the process limestone becomes marble, and granite forms its distinctive strength, which makes it useful in construction.

Metamorphic rocks remind me of men's ministry. Men who become bedrock anchors for their church develop slowly, and over time are shaped by and proven by the heat and pressure of Christian living.

A man who continues to grow and mature over the long haul will become both disciplined and disciplined. These men take time to solidify both Christian living and doctrinal constructs.

Do not be conformed to his age, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind, so that you may discern what is the good, pleasing, and perfect will of God. Romans 12:2 (HCSB)

The word translated 'transformed' is the Greek word that became the English word 'metamorphosis'. Men who endure the heat and pressure of Christian living become transformed into something greater.
